

## **JUCO FAQ's**

### **Where can I purchase JUCO tickets?**

Tickets may be purchased via our website [www.monumentalevents.com](http://www.monumentalevents.com), via phone by calling: 800-626-TIXS (8497), the Avalon Theatre box office (Mon-Sat 12p-8p), or at the gate 90 minutes prior to the start of the first game.

### **How much are JUCO Tickets?**

#### **GENERAL ADMISSION: SINGLE GAME**

- Single Day Game - \$10 Advance / \$12 at Suplizio Field
- Single Night Game - \$12 Advance / \$15 at Suplizio Field
- Single Game Child (ages 6-12) \$5
- Children (age 5 & under) - Free

#### **GENERAL ADMISSION: TOURNAMENT PASS**

- Adult - \$35 Advance / \$45 at Suplizio Field
- Students (ages 6-21) / Seniors(65+) - \$25 Advance / \$35 at Suplizio Field
- Children (age 5 & under) - Free

#### **RESERVED: SINGLE GAME (tower section: E,F,G,H)**

- Day Game - \$12 Advance, \$15 at Suplizio Field
- Night Game - \$15 Advance, \$18 at Suplizio Field

#### **RESERVED: TOURNAMENT PASS**

- Tower section - \$152 (Not Available After May 25, 2018)
- Grandstand section - \$76 (Not Available After May 25, 2018)

### **Where do I pickup my will call tickets?**

Beginning May 21, tournament passes and will call tickets will be available at Suplizio Field South Entrance Box Office from 10am-6p. Tickets may also be picked up any time during the tournament regular box office hours, which start 90 minutes prior to the first game each day. You may be asked for proof of purchase or a valid ID.

### **Where is handicap seating?**

- General Admission: Section N, Section O, or the breezeway/mezzanine in the tower.
- Reserved Seating: Section H

### **Is the tournament pass good for all the games?**

Yes, it is good for all 18 or 19 games, which includes the championship game. We do not know if there will be a game 19 until the tournament is in progress.

### **How far in advance of games do the gates open?**

Gates open 90 minutes before game start.

### **Do kids get in for free?**

Kids 5 and under are free. In the reserved section kids must sit on a parents lap otherwise they will need to purchase a seat.

### **Are there any military discounts?**

No, except on Monday all active military and veterans get in free with valid id. We do NOT give them a ticket, they will just show their id at the gate. Offer is only valid for military member; family members must pay. This is for Grandstand non reserved seats.

**Where can I purchase JUCO Banquet tickets?**

The JUCO banquet will be held on Friday, May 25, 2018 at Two Rivers Convention Center located at 159 Main Street in Downtown Grand Junction. Social hour is at 6pm and dinner at 7pm. Tickets are \$50 each and can be purchased via phone from the JUCO Office, 970-245-9166 or in-person at the JUCO Office in the Home Loan Building at 4th Street and Rood Avenue. **Do you have a schedule/program I can have?**

Schedules/programs can be purchase inside the stadium. Team names will be posted on the bracket as soon as they qualify. Some teams do not qualify until late May.

**Where do team parents sit?**

Coaches will be given cards that allow the parents to sit behind their team's dugout (section E or sections O & P) during their scheduled game. In addition, to the card the parents will also need a general admission ticket to get into the stadium.

**Can I bring a cooler?**

Yes, as long as it is a small handheld size (example: H9"xW12"xL9"). You are allowed to bring outside food & drinks into the stadium. Glass bottles are not allowed.

**Is there plenty of parking at the ballpark?**

Parking is VERY limited. Please arrange for alternate transportation to the park such as Hotel shuttles or Grand Valley Transit.
